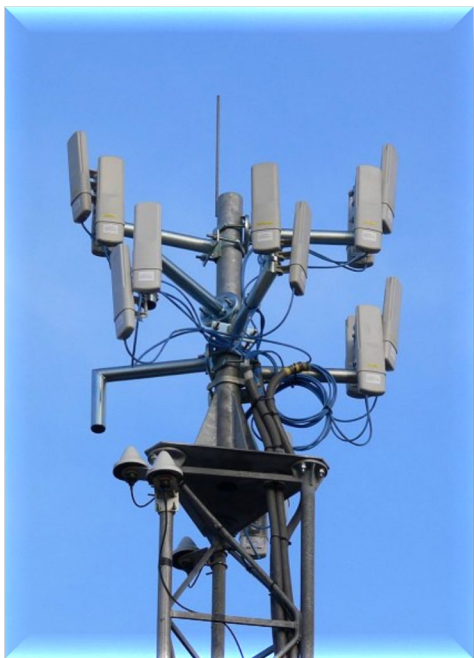

- Now has Wi-Fi

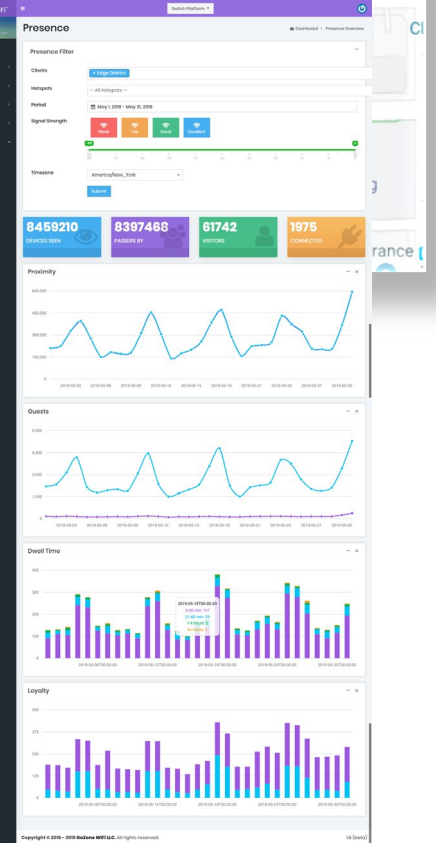
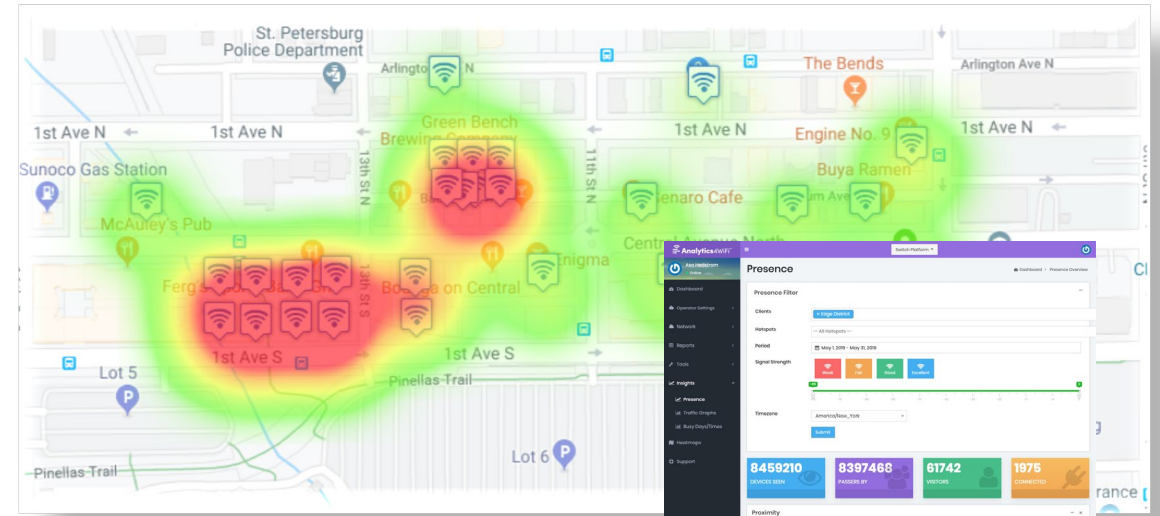
